

Prefix Registration

The initial part of a Dog's name is the Prefix.

- Queensland Working Cattle Dog Trial Assoc Inc. Dog Breeders may use a standard Prefix when naming Dogs, if registered.
- Members may register a Prefix for standard naming of Dogs or use a different name (including Prefix) for each Dog registered.

To register a Prefix, you must be a current member of the Association.

Why should I register a Prefix?

- A Registered Prefix creates an individual identity for the QWCDTAI Member and their Dogs.
- It is a perfect way of recognising the Breeder and Dogs bred for years to come.
- It provides a convenient and simple way to name Dogs.
- The performance of Dogs bred by the Breeder and overall success of the Breeder are easily recognised.
- At sales, Dogs bred or appearing in pedigrees are easily identified as being from the Breeder.
- It is a way of promoting the Breeder and all it has to offer, under one identity.

For eligibility, please consider the following:

(If registrar is aware of similar/same prefixes in other Registries/Associations your preference may be rejected)
